actually won an award for the water quality testing.

extinguishers. Jonah, Miesakie and Levi already  
working on the water lake temporary solution. C&GS  
have already agreed to pay for the actual repair during  
the summer. They would remove the hose and replace  
the pump. We will be trying to move Pond Inlet up the  
priority list for a new water station due to the problems
